The fees as approved be communicated to the individual institute/college. If the fee approved by the Authority is not acceptable to any individual institute/college then such institute/college may file the Review Application within fifteen days from the date of receipt of communication of fees approved by the Fees Regulating Authority.

The fees as approved can be maximum fees that can be charged and recovered from the students by the concern college/institute. The term "fees" has been defined under section 2(g) of the Maharashtra



Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 and same reads as under:-

"Fees" means the amount fixed as fee which includes tuition fee, library fee, gymkhana fee, examination fee, development fee or amount payable for any curricular or co-curricular activities, laboratory fee, information brochure fee and any other amount collected from the students, by whatsoever name called, and accepted in whichever manner, that is made payable to a Private Professional Educational Institution, for whatever purpose, by any candidate admitted to a professional course at such institution, but excludes any charges payable towards use of any optional hostel accommodation, mess charges and Students Insurance Fees,"

Thus any amount accepted by the institutions in cash or kind, directly or indirectly in excess of the fee approved by the Authority amounts to an Act of "profiteering" as defined under section 2(s) of the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 and the Management of such Institution liable for penal action as provided u/s 20 of the said Act of 2015.

Follow up action be taken accordingly".
