Item No. 1: To confirm the minutes of the 73rd Meeting of the Fees Regulating Authority.

Item No. 3: To consider the complaint in newspaper of Dilkap College of Engineering, Neral regarding teaching and non-teaching staff working in the college.

Office bearers of Dilkap College of Engineering, Neral visited the office. We have heard them. They have explained that college has number of adequate teaching faculties. They sought time to produce the record. For the present, no action appears necessary.

Item No. 4: To consider and decide on the inspection report with respect of nursing colleges in Wardha District.

Item No. 5: To co-ordinate with Social Justice Department in the matter of colleges collecting fees from those students whose fees are reimbursed by the said department.

It is resolved to communicate with Social Justice Department about some educational institutions collecting fees from student of SC/ST/OBC categories. The Authority feels that the joint awareness campaign is necessary. Secretary is requested to discuss the issue with Social Justice Department.

<u>Item No. 6</u>: <u>To review and discuss with joint operation / inspection of nursing colleges conducted by FRA and DMER, Mumbai.</u>

The Chairperson and Secretary, Medical Education and Drugs Department have discussed the issue. The step proposed by the Medical Education and Drugs Department to conduct inspection of nursing colleges is required to be welcome. Whenever inspection is undertaken, this Authority will depute one or two officers to join the inspection team. Director, Medical Education and Research may be informed accordingly.

<u>Item No. 7</u>: <u>To review and discuss the matter of Medical and Dental colleges collecting excess fee from student in NRI / Institutional quotas.</u>

(i) It is resolved to share information about fixation / non fixation of fees of Private Professional Unaided colleges with Admission Regulating Authority. In the process of admission the Admission Regulating Authority may make it mandatory for the institution / colleges to get their fees approved by Fees Regulating Authority for that academic year. The Authority may refuse to allot student to such institution whose fees have not been approved by the Fees Regulating Authority for that academic year.
