### NOTICE

**Sub : Fees to be charged to students admitted for PG course in Medical Colleges.**

All concerned to take note that the Fees Regulating Authority, State of Maharashtra in its meeting held on 24/4/2018, after considering the letter dated 24/4/2018 received from Department of Medical Education and Drugs, Government of Maharashtra has resolved as under :

**"Item No. 4: Any other matter with the permission of chair.**

**i) To consider letter dated 24/4/2018 received from Deputy Secretary, Medical Education and Drugs Department, Mumbai regarding multiple fee structure for PG course in Medical Colleges.**

***The Government considers it appropriate for the Institutions/Medical Colleges to collect fees with upper limit of four times the regular fees from the students admitted against Institutional/Management quota in Medical PG courses.***

***It is believed that the Government has legitimate reason and necessary data to suggest increase in the fee structure for Institutional/Management quota students. This Authority does not see any reason not to accede to the suggestion made by the Government.***

***Accordingly, Office to communicate above decision to the concerned and also place it on the website of this Authority."***

In view of above quoted decision, the Unaided Private Medical colleges running P.G. courses cannot charge the fees more than 4 times the regular fees from the students admitted against Institutional / Management quota.



Similarly, as per decision dated 19/3/2018, taken by the Fees Regulating Authority, the upper limit of 5 times of regular fees has been prescribed for students admitted to P.G. course by the Unaided Private Medical Colleges.

All the Unaided Private Medical Colleges running P.G. courses are directed to strictly follow the decision dated 19/3/2018 and 24/4/2018 prescribing the upper limit of fees to be charged to students admitted under Institutional / Management as well as NRI quota.
