## NOTICE

All the Students/Parents are hereby informed that the subject of multiple fee structures for the students seeking admission against seats available for NRI and Institutional Quotas in Unaided Private Professional Colleges imparting health sciences courses was discussed in the Fees Regulating Authority meeting dated 19<sup>th</sup> March, 2018 and the following decision was taken:

Decision:

"As regards quantum of fee structures, we consider that maximum limit shall be 5 times and 3 times for the students admitted against NRI and Institutional Quotas respectively. Provided that institutions before start of admission process shall be required to declare its fee structures for respective quotas, discipline wise / course wise on its website as well as on the website of Director, Medical Education and Research, Mumbai and Fees Regulating Authority."

Thereafter, the letter dated 24-04-2018 received from the Deputy Secretary, Medical Education and Drugs Department, Mumbai regarding multiple fees structure for PG courses in Medical Colleges was placed before the Fees Regulating Authority meeting dated 24-04-2018 and the following decision was taken:

## Ref: Decision dated 19-03-2018 about multiple structure fees.

"The Government considers it appropriate for the Institutions/Medical Colleges to collect fees with upper limit of four times the regular fees from the students admitted against Institutional/Management Quota in Medical PG courses.

It is believed that the Government has legitimate reason and necessary data to suggest increase in the fee structure for Institutional/Management quota students. This Authority does not see any reason not to accede to the suggestion made by the Government."

It is further hereby informed that the complaints against the Institutions/ Colleges, for demanding/charging over and above fees for Institutional/NRI Quotas at the time of admission be lodged to the office of the Admission Regulating Authority, Mumbai  $-400\ 001$ .

The complaints against the Institutions/Colleges inrespect of accepting/demanding over and above fees than approved by the Fees Regulating Authority, for students selected through CAP round / belongs to open category only, be lodged, alongwith the photocopies of the receipts to the Fees Regulating Authority.

All the Students/Parents are requested to take note thereof.
